s + f = sf

Explication: The 'sf' symbol is an abbreviation of sensory (s) and friendly (f), obviously :-)  
We combined those two letters into a single glyph. In Latin script, this is known as ligature  
- it's similar to ligatures like 'æ' (a+e) or 'œ' (o+e). Maybe you know, maybe not,  
even the '&' glyph originates in latin "et" (which means "and") and through  
handwritten combination (e+t) it developed into single glyph '&'.

Yes, typographers may hate us as we did some shitty graphic changes.

Like for instance: we shifted the baseline of glyphs, connected 's' to the arm of 'f', moved the arm itself, and ... the worst ... we copied f's terminal and made it into its tail!

Well, sorry guys - love us or hate us, we like it anyway.



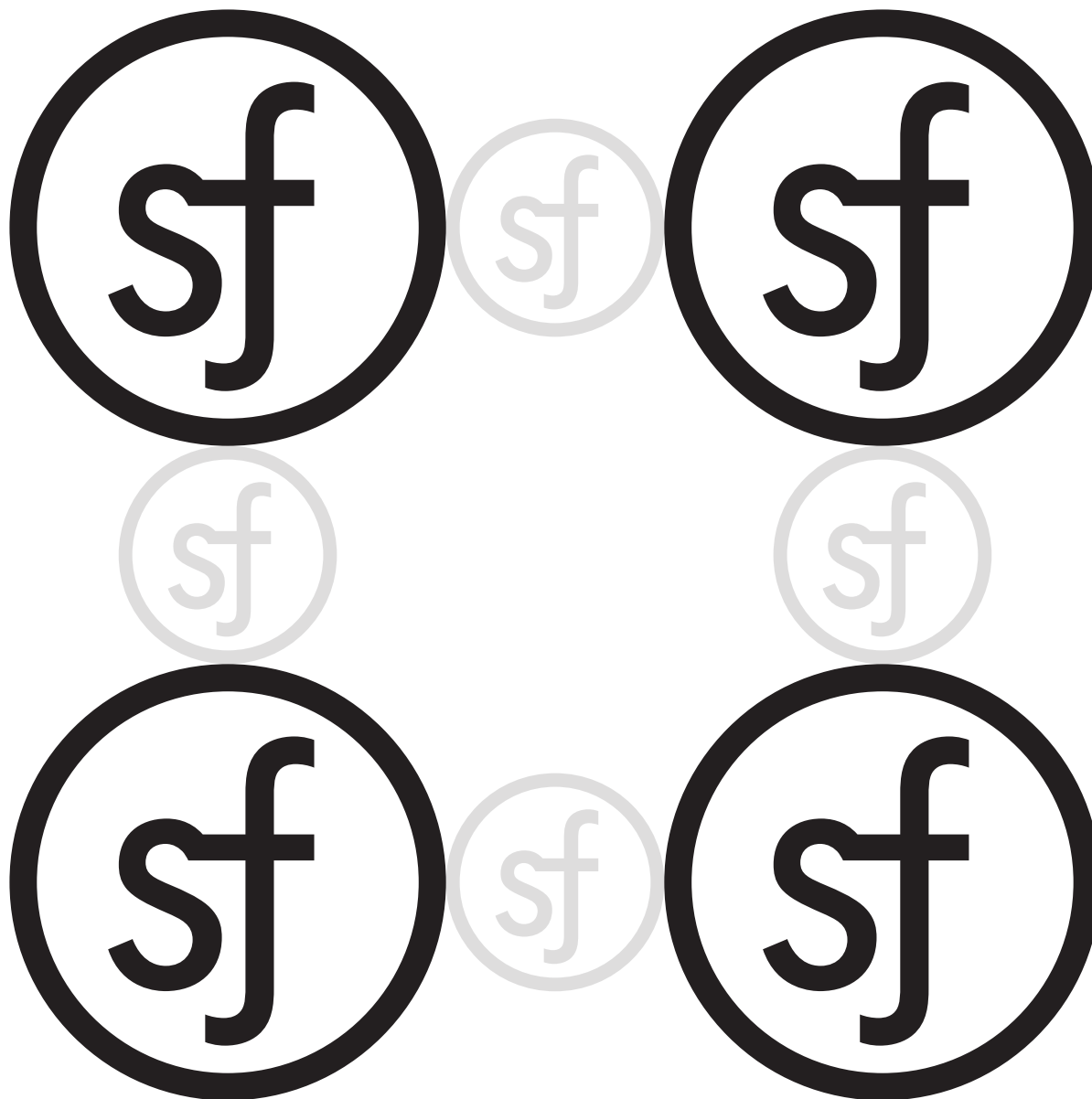
And then, we've just put it all into a circle of kinda same thickness as the glyph's lines. Ta-da!
